SONG OF STARS pressed the pace outside COOL JOE BROWN, took over from that rival at the quarter pole, then drew away. CHAIRMAN TUCKER chased the pace into the stretch but was no match for the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. VALERIUS unhurried after breaking slowly, passed tired rivals for the show. SHOW TRIAL well placed while saving ground, couldn't keep pace in the drive. COOL JOE BROWN set the pace under pressure along the inside to nearing the quarter pole, then tired. NO ACT broke poorly, moved up to chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then faltered. HEY JACK off slowly, was outrun. EARLY CHRISTMAS showed early foot and faded. BLUE TAPE was done early.
