SIR RABBIT reserved off the pace, steadied to avoid running up on a rival entering the far turn, eased out to race five wide into the stretch, then rallied to be just up at the wire. TANGLED TANGO chased the pace, moved to take over from BE WELCOME on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then just failed to last. EXCLUSIVE STRIKE rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, then responded to pressure in the drive and rallied to just miss the place. SARATOGA MATT allowed to settle, saved ground to nearing the stretch, eased out and finished willingly. DAVID K outran early, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. BALLAST (IRE) tracked the pace three wide, made a run to join TANGLED TANGO on the far turn, raced with that rival into the stretch, then was being outfinished when checked from tight quarters late. HE'S ALRIGHT stalked the pace into the stretch and gave way. UNTUTTABLE AFFAIR taken in hand early, circled rivals four wide to reach contention on the far turn, then tired. WHY TONTO chased the pace, then was steadied in traffic leaving the far turn and failed to recover. IL POSTINO fractious loading into the gate, was never a factor. BE WELCOME quickly

moved to the fore, made the pace along the inside into the far turn, then was fading when steadied leaving that turn.
