Footnotes

QUIET DANGER set the pace along the rail, drew clear in midstretch, then was fully extended to hold off TURKISH. The latter, reserved early, swung wide for the stretch run and was gaining on the winner at the finish. MONEY'S WORTH rated off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and finished willingly

while being edged for the place. IL VOLO well placed while saving ground, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch but didn't do enough late. PACK LEADER outrun after bumping with GRAD STUDENT at the start, saved ground, eased out in the stretch and closed with a belated rally. CANADIAN FLAG stalked the pace off the rail, eased three wide on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. MYLES prompted the pace outside QUIET DANGER into the stretch and tired. KANPAI steadied along the inside on the first turn and failed to menace. GREYRUNFORNV was not a factor. GRAD STUDENT was outrun after bumping with PACK LEADER at the start. ABSOLUTE MONARCH off slowly, showed little. T. V. PLASMA was never close.
