MILWAUKEE BREW broke sharply, dueled for the lead onto the far turn, drew off and won convincingly. TUCKAWAY BOY was away alertly, allowed to settle off the pace, commenced a rally in the stretch and hung, just held place. HIGHEST MOUNTAIN was taken back shortly after the start, unhurried for three-quarters and closed a late gap. PROSPECTOR GO was shut off and taken up at the start, got through along the inside entering the stretch and failed to sustain the bid. PINEBLOOM bore in at the start, showed good speed while pressing the pace for a half, gave way on the far turn. COURAGIOUS COUP demonstrated good early speed, led for a half and tired. FOOLISH HALO was close up in the early going, caught four wide entering the first turn and stopped shortly thereafter.
