NEMO LANDING chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then responded to pressure and wore down LITTLEWINGED late to prevail. LITTLEWINGED showed speed off the rail, responded when challenged in the stretch, then gave way grudgingly in the final sixteenth. STARSHIP STEVE chased the pace along the rail, made a run to reach near even terms for command at the eighth pole, then gave way. DOC GREEN rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and had no late response. THEGREATCROSBY reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and tired. CAPE TOWN KING was no factor after hesitating at the start. BRASSIE PRINCE raced five wide and faltered.
