SO MUCH LOVE chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over at the top of the stretch and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to remain clear to the wire. GO GO LOLO tracked the pace three wide, advanced to reach the attending position in the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while proving second best. TROPIC OF AQUARIUS reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, passed tired rivals for the show. LADYMEDAGLIA D'ORO off slowly, was unhurried early, then improved her position without threatening. DEPUTY MAJOR showed speed along the inside to the top of the stretch, then gave way. AFLEETING LADY broke to the inside, raced four wide around the turn and tired. LADY LINDY was caught in tight at the start, raced three wide around the turn and faltered. ROYAL SEPTOR chased the pace along the rail into the turn, then faded.
