SILVER CLOUD showed speed off the rail, drew clear around the turn and into the stretch, then remained clear to the wire under urging. BIG BENTLEY chased the pace along the rail, eased out for the stretch run and couldn't get to the winner while proving best of the others. VOYLES chased the pace into the stretch and weakened. THUNDERING WATERS rated off the pace, closed with a mild response to just miss the show. MR. VALENTINE off a step slowly, saved ground and lacked a late response. MORE THAN NOBLE off slowly, failed to menace. SIMMSTOWN tracked the leaders three wide around the turn and gave way. BLACKSTONE BAY fractious in the gate, was outrun after he dwelt at the start. HOME RUN STORM broke a step slowly, then checked in behind BIG BENTLEY on the backstretch and was not a factor.
