MISS QUISQUEYA bumped with AWESOME FIRE at the start, stalked the pace four wide, rallied to reach the leaders approaching the eighth pole, then wore those rivals down to be just up at the wire. CRESpano pressed the pace outside BROWN EYED NANCE, gained a slim lead from that rival in the stretch, then just failed to last. BROWN EYED NANCE set the pace under pressure off the rail into the stretch and continued on gamely while just being edged to the wire. FIVE STAR MOMMA off slowly, stalked the pace off the rail, angled out in the stretch and had no response when asked. SINISTER TALE chased the pace along the rail around the turn and gave way. AWESOME FIRE rated off the pace after bumping with MISS QUISQUEYA at the start, faded in the drive.
