**Footnotes**

COUNSELOR CABOT chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over in early stretch, then drew away under pressure. LILY THE PINK stalked the pace off the rail, angled out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. MONGOS EXPRESSION set the pace along the rail into the stretch, then gave way. BELLA BANDITA unhurried early, saved ground and improved her position without threatening. DADDY'S KISS failed to menace. IRISH WEDDING was not a factor. SHEBA'S SECRET reserved off the pace, saved ground and tired. CLAIRE'S SONG stalked the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then faltered. A TIME TO LOVE off slowly, was outrun. MICROBABE showed little.
