ADAMS CASTLE chased the pace, rallied to reach even terms for command at the eighth pole, then dueled with MIESQUES TESTIMONY to the wire and prevailed. The latter, showed speed along the inside, responded when challenged by ADAMS CASTLE in the stretch, then dueled with that rival and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. DUCHESS OF COCOA raced in striking position three wide around the turn and lacked a late response. WALKES SPRING unhurried after breaking slowly, saved ground into the stretch, angled out and passed tired rivals. GREEN MEADOW saved ground and failed to menace. SLEWADORA off slowly, raced four wide on the turn and was not a factor. MARIOLA chased the leaders to nearing the stretch and tired. DEAR TO MY HEART raced three wide and faltered. PHANTOM SONG was through early.
