Footnotes

TOP CROSS outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up late. FAITH'S MAGIC steadied in traffic on the first turn, raced four wide on the far turn, rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole but couldn't resist the winner in the closing strides. BELLO CAPOTE steadied along the inside entering the first turn, saved ground to nearing the stretch, angled out for racing room and closed with a late rush to be up for the show. LE DAUPHIN vied for the lead along the rail, was easing back off LASER when steadied inside that rival on the far turn, recovered and finished willingly while just being edged for the show. I AIN'T NO SAINT stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. LASER vied for the lead outside LE DAUPHIN, opened a clear lead when that rival steadied on the far turn, made the pace to the sixteenth pole and gave way. DUG IN rated off the pace, moved up four wide around the far turn, then bumped ARTIE HOT soundly when he lugged in on the rival in early stretch and tired. CHIEF OPERATOR stalked the pace into the stretch and faltered. ARTIE HOT unhurried after breaking slowly, was attempting to split rivals when knocked into PORT CLYDE and steadied in early stretch, then never threatened. PORT CLYDE reserved off the pace, steadied in traffic on the far turn, then was bumped soundly in early stretch and dropped back. FORT APACHE STAR tracked the pace along the rail, then steadied on the far turn and faded. WONDEROUS GLORY was done early.
