

**GULFSTREAM PARK - March 26, 2011 - Race 10**

STAKES Pan American S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday, March 12, 2011, \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$90,000, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry at a fee of \$7,500, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes over nine furlongs on the turf since July 1, allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes over nine furlongs since August 1, 4 lbs., \$45,000 over nine furlongs since September 1, 6 lbs., Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 Starters, with Also Eligibles. If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2009-2011 earnings. In the event this stakes is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. Trophy to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Quarter) (Rail at 84 feet).

RAHY'S ATTORNEY prompted the pace outside BECKHAM BEND, took over from that rival at the quarter pole, then was all out to prevail. MUSKETIER (GER) reserved along the inside for a mile, began moving up around the final turn, angled outside the leaders for the stretch run and gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. PRINCE WILL I AM taken in hand for a mile, lost position around the final turn, made a run off the rail to loom a threat at the eighth pole but couldn't gain late. LOUP BRETON (IRE) unhurried while saving ground into the final turn, swung out for the stretch run and gained some ground without threatening. POOL PLAY allowed to settle, advanced three wide around the final turn, bumped with ELDAAFER in the stretch, then didn't do enough late and his rider lost his whip. ELDAAFER rated off the pace, advanced into contention on the final turn, then bumped with POOL PLAY in the stretch and gave way. BECKHAM BEND set the pace along the rail to the quarter pole, then tired.
