Footnotes

OLYMPIC DANZ (BRZ) stalked the pace along the inside, eased out and rallied to catch BLUE TAPE just inside the eighth pole, then was all out to hold off GIANT MOVE. The latter, rated off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place while unable to catch the winner. CHINSEGUT BAY reserved off the pace, advanced along the inside around the far turn, then finished willingly for the show. HARKEN UP outran early, swung wide for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. COFFEE BREAK unhurried early, angled out at the top of the stretch for room and finished full of run. WILD ENTRY (JPN) allowed to settle, advanced to reach contention in the stretch but had no further response. BLUE TAPE outran UPSHOTBEST for the lead around the first turn and eased to the inside, made the pace to the eighth pole, then gave way. GONE STRAIGHT saved ground and never threatened. UPSHOTBEST prompted the pace outside BLUE TAPE to the quarter pole, then tired. FATHER LUCEY tracked the pace four wide to midway of the far turn and faltered. POWER RULES chased the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then faded. FOOLISH HONOR was no factor while racing three wide.
