SPEIGHTSTOWN bobbled slightly at the start, moved up along the rail to contest the early pace, dueled inside PRETTY WILD to the top of the stretch, shook loose in upper stretch then drew off while being kept to the task. PRETTY WILD bumped, at the start, pressed the pace outside the winner for a half, battled heads apart on the turn but couldn't stay with SPEIGHTSTOWN through the final eighth. WACKY FOR LOVE stalked three wide along the backstretch, edged closer on the turn then closed late to narrowly miss for the place. DANCING GUY raced well back after being pinched at the start, advanced three wide on the turn then rallied mildly. JERSEY GIANT saved ground to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. FIRE AND GLORY raced within striking distance while three wide for five furlongs and lacked a strong closing response. VINEMEISTER was reserved for a half, circled five wide on the turn and flattened out. PASS RUSH lacked a rally while four wide throughout. DEER LAKE bobbled at the start, moved up along the rail, raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground to the turn and faded.
