**Footnotes**

SILVERSIDER quickly moved to the fore while angling over to the inside, made the pace into the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. WAQUOIT'S LOVE stalked the pace three wide into the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while edging THE NIAGARA QUEEN for the place. The latter, stalked the winner into the stretch but had no late response and was outgamed for the place. IRON DOVE off slowly, was steadied in the early going, raced in striking position into the stretch and couldn't gain late. CROESUS was caught in tight early, saved ground into the stretch and lacked a rally. GRAND OIR failed to menace after being checked from tight quarters in the early going. YOUNG GLORY steadied from tight quarters soon after the start and was not a factor. KATS GOLDEN WAYS rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and tired. LOVELORN tracked the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. FAIRY PRINCESS allowed to settle after clipping heels in the early going, moved into contention four wide on the far turn, then faded. PATTI TIFF was outrun after being steadied in the early going.
