Footnotes

NAISSANCE ROYALE (IRE) rated off the pace, rallied three wide on the far turn to reach even terms for command with ESPLANADE, then dueled with that rival to the wire and prevailed. ESPLANADE chased the pace, moved up to reach even terms for command on the far turn, then dueled with NAISSANCE ROYALE through the stretch and was edged to the wire. JUST A LITTLE JET reserved early, advanced four wide on the far turn to loom a threat, then flattened out. MOUNTAIN MAMBO well placed in behind the leaders, was checked to avoid running up on rivals on the far turn and couldn't gain late. TALE OF FREEDOM allowed to settle, made a run to reach contention on the far turn, then tired in the drive. BOBCAT GREELEY was outrun. TRAVOIS was no factor after being steadied at the start. LEGENDARY JOURNEY sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace into the far turn, then faded and was eased in the stretch run.
