SKATING rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run, rallied take over nearing the eighth pole, then drew clear. CHINOOK WIND (IRE) unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and rallied to prove best of the rest while unable to get to the winner. TOWN FLIRT stalked the pace, angled three wide on the far turn, made a run to reach the leaders in early stretch, then was steadied from close quarters at the eighth pole and gave way. STRIKING WONDER reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, then closed to just miss the show. ALLEGREZZA stalked the pace, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then tired. ABACO raced three wide and failed to menace. ARE BABA was not a factor. MISS MEXIQUE set the pace along the rail to midway of the far turn, then faltered. STYLUS tracked the pace along the inside into the far turn, then faltered.
