SAINT LIAM rated just off the pace in the five path, started his bid on the final turn then dueled with a short lead from the quarter pole to preserve a slim margin. BEST MINISTER drifted outward into the opening turn, raced unhurriedly in mid pack, bid outside on the final turn, dueled at the neck of the winner from the quarter pole but couldn't get by. OUI OUI MON AMIE rated just off the pace off the rail, gave chase three wide through the final turn, was eased out for the drive and finished evenly. DYLAN rated with the pace in the four path, contested with a short lead on the final turn, dropped back entering the stretch and gave way. SLEUTHING steadied briefly early on, was carried out entering the opening turn, made a mild bid into the final turn then proved empty in the stretch. TO GOD'S EARS rated with the pace in the three path, contested briefly on the final turn then gave way. WEST POINT GENT, off the pace toward the rail, was eased out through the final turn and tired widest. TIPPECANOE never factored. RAYON rated the pace just off the rail, dropped back nearing the final turn then faded through the turn.
