Footnotes

HEDGEFUND INVESTOR set the pace along the inside into the stretch, then was fully extended to hold YAROSLAV safe. The latter, rated in striking position off the pace while racing three wide, rallied for the place. SOUL SPIRIT reserved early, raced four wide around the far turn and closed with a mild

response to be up for the show. FIND THE WIRE unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and closed with a belated rally. BENEATH THE CROWN tracked the pace, was shuffled back racing into the stretch, angled out and finished willingly. PAISANO CREEK outrun early, advanced between horses to reach contention in the stretch but didn't do enough late. B B'S CONCORDE well placed along the rail after being steadied soon after the start, advanced to reach contention in the stretch, then flattened out. WOODEN INDIAN stalked the pace three wide, was steadied in traffic on the far turn and gave way. AQAB allowed to settle, lacked room through the stretch and couldn't threaten. PEACEFUL RUSSIAN saved ground and failed to menace. JACK'S ELEVEN chased the pace into the stretch and tired. BORDEAUX BANDIT was not a factor.
