STAKES Orchid S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday, March 13, 2010, \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$1,500 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$90,000, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to sixth.

Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry at a fee of \$6,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 123 lbs.

Non-winners of a graded/group stakes over nine furlongs on the turf in 2010 allowed 2 lbs.; of a graded sweepstakes over nine furlongs in 2009-2010 4 lbs., \$60,000 over nine furlongs since September 1, 6 lbs. In the event this stakes is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 13, 2010 with 24 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Quarter) (Rail at 84 feet).

SPEAK EASY GAL set the pace along the rail, edged away in early stretch, then was all out to just last over LADY SHAKESPEARE. The latter, reserved racing along the inside into the stretch the final time, angled out and rallied to just miss. NEHANTIC KAT stalked the pace, eased out for the stretch run and finished willingly to be up for the show. MUSHKA unhurried early, advanced along the outside in the run through the stretch the first time to reach the leaders, raced with those rivals three wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. MAGICAL THEATER allowed to settle for more than a mile, angled out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. LIBERALLY (IRE) well placed while saving ground, closed with a mild response. CELTIC PRINCESS (BRZ) rank in the early going, prompted the pace outside SPEAK EASY GAL into the stretch the final time, then gave way. CABLE failed to menace. WHO PLAYS BRAHMS was through after a mile.
