HAMMERING BUCKEYE chased KING ANDREW into the stretch, then wore that rival down under pressure to be just up at the wire. KING ANDREW showed speed along the inside, edged clear in the stretch but couldn't resist the winner at the wire. IN SPEIGHT OF IT reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and closed to gain the show while unable to best to the top ones. GOT THAT ITCH failed to menace. FUENCIA unhurried early, was saving ground when steadied on the turn and never threatened. DOUBLE JUDGE chased the leaders three wide around the turn, then tired. STOMP rated off the pace, faltered in the drive. RUPERTS COOKIE showed brief speed, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
