XODO tracked the pace, angled three wide on the far turn, rallied to take over at the eighth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. BRITISH BANKER reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and was gaining on the winner at the finish. MARL rated off the pace, eased out and made a run to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't sustain his bid. FASTUS CACTUS was forced out by SAFETY SQUEEZE when that rival came out to try and savage him racing into the first turn, outran that one for the lead around the first turn, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. CARTOUCHE well placed early, made a run four wide around the far turn to loom a threat entering the stretch, then weakened. TODAY'S MAN allowed to settle while saving ground, rallied along the rail to reach the leaders in the stretch, then tired. SAFETY SQUEEZE drifted out racing into the first turn while trying to savage FASTUS CACTUS, chased that rival into the stretch and faltered. COPPER CASCADE was not a factor. FOOLISH HONOR was outrun.
