GOLD KNIFE rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, then rallied to be just up at the wire. WHY SHOULD I chased the pace along the rail, moved to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole but couldn't resist the winner at the wire. CORINTHIAN LEATHER reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and closed with a mild response to be up for the show. SHEZA FUN SPONGE showed speed off the rail to inside the eighth pole, then lugged in under right-handed pressure nearing the sixteenth pole and weakened. CASSIDILLY failed to menace. EMMANUELA was no factor after being steadied in the early going. SALVAR well placed early, tired. ESCANDALOSA was outrun. TWYLIGHT COCKTAILS chased the pace three wide around the turn and faltered. ROMAN SCORE off slowly, saved ground and faded.
