SHERRY ANGEL stalked the pace along the inside, angled outside the leaders at the top of the stretch, then rallied under pressure to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole and edged away. BACK BAYOU chased the pace off the rail, moved to gain a slim lead in the stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner late. JULIEANNAMO showed speed along the rail into the stretch, responded when BACK BAYOU moved to the fore but was outfinished. ELLEN G stalked the pace off the rail into the stretch and gave way. PURE TREASURE bumped with DIPLOMATIC GAL soon after the start, saved ground around the turn and tired. JEREZANA tracked the leaders three wide around the turn, then faltered. LA BARBIE NIKI was no factor after being steadied when bumped by DIPLOMATIC GAL soon after the start. DIPLOMATIC GAL was outrun after being steadied when knocked into LA BARBIE NIKI in the early going. DUBLIN'S DIAMOND raced three wide and was done early. ROOT FOR THE CAT showed little.
