ORCHARD PARK tracked the pace, rallied three wide to gain command on the far turn, then was roused to draw clear in the stretch. EMERGENCY STATUS showed speed along the inside while rank early, was taken in hand racing down the backstretch, reopened a clear lead on the far turn, then couldn't stay with the winner in the drive while holding the place. BERNIE B unhurried early, eased out for the drive and closed with a mild rally to be up for the show while missing the place. QUICK TALKER outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. CHARMING COLONY checked along the inside leaving the chute, was checked again to avoid running up on EMERGENCY STATUS on the first turn, angled out leaving the far turn while moving into contention, then weakened. NICE BOY tracked the pace into the far turn and faltered. SUSIE'S POKER chased the pace along the hedge into the stretch and faded.
