### Footnotes

HERO'S TRIBUTE settled behind the early pacesetter, closed the gap leaving the backstretch, rallied between horses to gain a slim lead approaching the stretch, extended his advantage in upper stretch then drew off under steady right hand urging. AENEAS was unhurried for six furlongs, circled four wide on the turn then outfinished PUZZLEMENT for the place. PUZZLEMENT settled in good position, rallied between horses to threaten approaching the quarter pole but couldn't sustain his bid. STRIVE raced well back after being squeezed a bit at the start, circled four wide on the turn then improved his position with a mild late rally. BONUS PACK raced in close contention along the inside for a mile and lacked a strong closing bid. GENEROUS ROSI (GB) sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace along the inside to the turn and gave way. LEARNED failed to mount a serious rally. WINDSOR CASTLE raced within striking distance to the far turn and gave way.
