MAGIC TALK was reserved for five furlongs, circled six wide while rallying on the turn then closed steadily to get up in the late stages. UPLIFTING dueled along the inside into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. GOOD LANDING checked slightly along the inside on the first turn, settled for a half, angled four wide on the turn then finished willingly to gain a share. T E JONES chased the leaders while three wide to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. RIGHT OUT RO forced the pace from outside into upper stretch and tired. PYRITE WHO failed to mount a serious rally. BEAR WEST saved ground for a half, angled between horses on the turn then flattened out. VALUE ORIENTED was never a factor. ALIBOB failed to menace while racing wide.
