SPANGLED stalked the pace, moved to take over inside the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. DANCEWITHASOLDIER reserved off the pace after bumping with OMEYA in the early going, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. ERASE well placed racing along the rail, rallied to reach near even terms for command in midstretch but was outfinished. MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE rated off the pace after bumping with OMEYA in the early going, angled three wide on the far turn and advanced to reach contention in the stretch but had no late response. PAULA SMITH set the pace along the rail to inside the eighth pole and tired. EVERYBOTTIWINS allowed to settle, advanced into contention in the stretch, then drifted in and was steadied late. GLORIOSA was not a factor. OMEYA (CHI) was outrun after being bumped and steadied from between rivals in the early going. JOVIALNESS chased the pacesetter into the far turn and faltered. ABSOLUTELY LOVELY saved ground and faded.
