Footnotes

DROP IT NOW reserved racing along the inside, angled outside the leaders midway of the turn, rallied to gain the lead soon after entering the stretch, then drew away while being ridden out. MIZE THE BIG CAT outrun after bumping hard with UNTUTTABLE AFFAIR at the start, rallied to prove second best while unable to gain on the winner late. VARITEK pressed the pace outside FEDERAL EXCHANGE, took over from that rival nearing the quarter pole, made

the pace into the stretch, then gave way. RHYTHM OF THE MOON steadied from tight quarters leaving the chute, stalked the pace three wide, moved into the attending position racing to the quarter pole, then tired in the drive. VALERIUS raced wide throughout and failed to menace. TRITONK tracked the leaders four wide to nearing the stretch, then faltered. CARSON'S DASH was never a factor. WINGEDLIE raced five wide and dropped back. BRAVE APACHE chased the pace off the rail to midway of the turn, then had nothing left. UNTUTTABLE AFFAIR was outrun after bumping hard with MIZE THE BIG CAT at the start. FEDERAL EXCHANGE set the pace under pressure along the rail to midway of the turn, then faded. GENERAL GUTI showed early foot along the inside and stopped.
