STAKES Appleton S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. (\$15,000 bonus for FTBOA Registered Florida-Bred by an FTBOA Registered Florida Sire). Free nomination, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed. The owner of the winner to receive \$60,000, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth and \$2,000 to sixth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes on the turf in 2014 allowed 2 lbs.; of a graded stakes on the turf since October 1, 4 lbs., A graded stakes since August 1, or two races other than maiden or claiming since October 1, 6 lbs. In the event this stakes is taken off the turf it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. Supplemental Nominations at time of entry with a fee of \$5,000. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 15, 2014 with 43 Nominations and 1 Supplemental Nomination. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 24 feet).

Footnotes

HEY LEROY a bit headstrong when taken back to last soon after the start, remained unhurried into the far turn, swung out for the stretch, then rallied to be just up at the wire. MR. ONLINE pressed the early pace, took over racing down the backstretch, angled to the inside entering the far turn, opened a clear lead in midstretch, then drifted out late and just failed to last. SALTO (IRE) stalked the pace along the rail into the stretch, then didn't do enough late. TETRADRACHM rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed with a mild response without threatening. GRAND TITO stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. MIDNIGHT CELLO showed brief speed along the rail and tired. FREDERICKSBURG was never a factor after being caught out wide around the first turn. KHARAFa was stalking the pace when steadied on the backstretch, moved up around the far turn to reach the attending position, then faltered in the drive. FIVE IRON raced three wide and was through after a half mile.
