LA MADRINA reserved early, raced four wide around the turn, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole and drew off. JENNY'S ROCKET pressed the pace outside THIRTEEN ARROWS, took over from that rival leaving the turn and opened a clear lead but was no match for the winner late while clearly best of the rest. TIS DUET rated off the pace, was racing three wide when angled to the inside on the turn and passed tired rivals for the show. THIRTEEN ARROWS set the pace under pressure along the rail to past midway of the turn and tired. MARE ON FIRE failed to menace. CORINTHIAN LUCK off slowly, saved ground and never threatened. INDY'S MILLION was never a factor. MAKE IT SNAPPY was outrun after breaking slowly. CIRCLE THE EMPIRE chased the pace three wide to midway of the turn, then faltered. RUSSIAN NIGHT reluctant to load into the gate, showed little. NEWLY FASHIONED well placed early, faded.
