Footnotes

ONLY IN PHILLY chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole and was all out to prevail. SHAKESPEARESISTER (GB) unhurried early, angled four wide on the far turn, bumped with BARADORE approaching the eighth pole, then rallied to just miss. BARADORE (IRE) outrun early, rallied into contention leaving the far turn, bumped with SHAKESPEARESISTER nearing the eighth pole, angled in and made a run inside ONLY IN PHILLY to reach near even terms for command but was outgamed to the wire. MOUNTAIN MAMBO rated off the pace, split rivals leaving the far turn to reach even terms for command in the stretch but was outfinished. SAVING GROUND set the pace along the rail, was steadied when she leaned in too close to the rail nearing the eighth pole, then tired. SILVER PLATA steadied when caught in tight early, stalked the pace along the inside, then was steadied again when trapped in behind the leaders in midstretch and faltered. TIGER BELLE stalked the pace three wide into the far turn and faded. (The rail on the turf course was set at 84 feet).
