HOPES AND DREAMS was outrun for a half, swung out while gaining on the turn, circled six wide into the stretch and finished with a flourish to get up in the final twenty yards. DEAN'S LIST steadied in traffic on the first turn, saved ground for six furlongs, split rivals while gaining in midstretch then finished well between horses. FEISTY WOMAN checked slightly on the first turn, raced in good position along the inside, rallied along the rail to challenge in midstretch and yielded late. LE CORDON BLEU sprinted clear early, set the pace into midstretch and weakened. TROUBLE MAKER was pinched in tight at the start, raced in midpack to the turn, advanced three wide into the stretch and finished evenly. CRIMINOLOGIST chased the leader in the two path into midstretch and tired. TALENTED PRINCESS steadied along the rail for the first turn and never reached contention. MPENZI (GB) raced in traffic and failed to mount a serious rally while saving ground on the turn.
