MR. DUNKIN showed speed along the inside, drew clear in the stretch, then was fully extended to prevail. BROWN INDIAN chased the pace along the inside, eased out in the stretch and was gaining on the winner at the finish. SPECIAL EXCHANGE pressed the pace outside MR. DUNKIN, then weakened in the drive. HEAVY ON THEMISTER allowed to settle, angled out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. CHAGU MIO chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. HARBOR BREEZE bobbled soon after the start and failed to menace. GUDAHI saved ground to no avail. BANDMAN was not a factor. BRILLIANT VISION was outrun while saving ground. SEEKING THE COACH showed early foot, raced three wide around the turn and faded.
