SLAN ABHAILE set the pace under pressure along the inside, edged clear in the stretch, then was fully extended to prevail. SNEAKY BLOWOUT chased the pace three wide around the turn, was outmoved by the winner, then responded to pressure and was gaining on that rival late. MIDNIGHT CELLO well placed racing off the rail, couldn't keep pace with the top ones while gaining the show. ROMANSH moved up on the backstretch to press the pace outside SLAN ABHAILE to nearing the quarter pole, then tired. LITTLE JIMMY pressed the pace early pace, eased in to chase the winner along the rail around the turn and faltered. CATHOLIC COWBOY was no factor while racing three wide. BORGES stalked the pace three wide and faded. STIRLING CASTLE off slowly, showed early foot along the inside, then had nothing left. KING BALTHASAR was done early. CARSON CITY BREW was through after a half mile.
