**Footnotes**

BIG PRAIRIE tracked the pace, angled outside the leaders for the stretch, then rallied to be up late while attempting to lug in. FRIAR well placed racing along the rail, rallied in tight quarters through the stretch to edge SCALATOR for the place while being outfinished by the top one. SCALATOR set the pace under pressure along the inside, then gave way grudgingly in the closing strides. THUNDER AGAIN reserved early, closed with a mild response in the drive. RUMSPRINGA stalked the pace three wide, made a run to join the leaders on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. CHEERING THY NAME steadied in the early going, saved ground and failed to menace. ORACLE OF OMAHA allowed to settle after breaking slowly, lacked a rally. MIAMI BEAT off slowly, was not a factor. BONNRITA was outrun. HONORING BLUE stumbled at the start, was steadied in the early going and again on the first turn, moved out to chase the pace four wide into the far turn, then tired. FRANKINCENSE pressed the pace into the far turn and faltered. LORD C. J. was through after a half mile. (The rail on the turf course was set at 24 feet).
