A. P. ARROW settled in good position, raced just off the pace three wide to the turn, made a run to challenge in midstretch then was fully extended to hold on in the closing strides. REHOBOTH raced well back for six furlongs, rallied four wide on the turn then closed strongly from outside to gain the place. POLITICAL FORCE pressed between horses into upper stretch, gained a slim lead in midstretch and weakened late. PALLADIO raced well back after breaking slowly, circled four wide on the turn and rallied belatedly. TOUCHED BY MADNESS raced in midpack, rallied along the inside on the turn, altered course to the outside in midstretch and rallied mildly. TAP DANCING MAUK raced between rivals swung wide on the turn and lacked a late bid. GOTTTCHA GOLD set the pace along the rail to the turn and gave away.
