Footnotes

DESTRIERO vied for the lead along the inside, then drew off through the stretch under urging. TEN BELLS rated off the pace, closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. WELL EXCUUZE ME reserved off the pace, angled to the inside on the turn, made a run to reach the attending position but couldn't stay with the winner while being outfinished for the place. EVIL POWDER chased the leaders three wide around the turn and tired. FABULOUS FRONTIER outrun early, improved his position without threatening. WORTHY WAGER off slowly, moved up quickly to vie for the lead outside DESTRIERO, then faltered in the drive. EXPOSED IMAGE was not a factor. STORM CHART was outrun after breaking slowly. TANGLED PASSION was through after a half mile. CUTIN THE TIMBER showed little.
