TO THE POINT (ARG) stalked the pace, moved to take over at the quarter pole and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to prevail. DEVELOPING STORY stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then rallied to prove second best. SOVEREIGN GRACE outrun early, swung out for the stretch run, then bumped with KATE'S HOLIDAY at the top of the stretch and closed well to be up for the show. KATE'S HOLIDAY unhurried early, bumped with SOVEREIGN GRACE while trying to avoid ALBALI at the top of the stretch, then steadied in midstretch and failed to menace while gaining some ground late. BLACK HONOR rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention, then gave way in the drive. LA TORERA chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then was tiring when JUST CALL MY NAME clipped heels with her at the top of the stretch. AMADORABLE chased the pace

along the inside into the far turn and faltered. CONSOLACION SUR failed to menace. BROOKS LASS set the pace along the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then faded. SHOT GUN DONNA outrun early, checked leaving the turn, swung wide and was not a factor. ALBALI reserved off the pace, was tripped up when JUST CALL MY NAME fell into her at the top of the stretch and unseated her rider. JUST CALL MY NAME allowed to settle after being checked racing into the first turn, was attempting to rally into contention when she clipped heels with LA TORERA at the top of the stretch and fell. There was a stewards inquiry into the spill. No action was taken.
