



TAKE CHARGE INDY quickly moved to the fore, made the pace in hand along the rail to nearing the quarter pole, responded when challenged by REVERON entering the stretch and reopened his advantage, then was fully extended to prevail. REVERON prompted the pace outside TAKE CHARGE INDY, made a run to reach even terms for command with that rival at the quarter pole but couldn't stay with that one while continuing on with good courage to hold the place. UNION RAGS taken in hand to stalk the pace off the rail, followed the top ones through into the stretch, angled outside those rivals approaching the sixteenth pole and found his best stride too late. EL PADRINO stalked the pace four wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. NECK 'IN NECK chased the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. FORT LOUDON rated off the pace, made a run five wide around the far turn to reach contention, then tired in the drive. NEWS PENDING unhurried into the far turn after breaking slowly, faltered. Z CAMELOT trailed and was eased in the stretch run.
