HIT IT RICH rated off the pace, began moving up around the final turn, then rallied under pressure to be up late. AQSAM sprinted to a clear lead, opened a commanding advantage racing through the stretch the first time, made the pace off the rail into the stretch but couldn't resist the winner late while saving the place. KEERTANA unhurried for more than a mile, swung out for the stretch run and closed well to just miss the place. WOODFORD BELLE allowed to settle, remained well back to nearing the stretch the final time, swung out for room and closed with a belated rally. HAPPY CLAPPER taken in hand for a mile, advanced into contention around the final turn but didn't do enough late. SHIMMERING MOMENT reserved racing along the inside, advanced around the final turn and into the stretch but lacked the needed late response. SENADA failed to menace. CLARINET saved ground and failed to be a factor. ZAPPARITION tracked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then tired.
