CORPORATE JUNGLE rated off the pace, eased four wide on the far turn, rallied to take over in early stretch, then was all out to prevail. TREND unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied for the place. MONUMENT HILL reserved racing along the inside, was moving up when forced to check in behind the leaders leaving the far turn, altered course to the outside when blocked in behind a wall of horses in the stretch, then closed to be up for the show. BEAU CHOIX outrun while saving ground, angled out in the stretch and closed with a belated rally. BRILLIANT SPEED taken in hand early, swung out for the stretch run and gained some ground without threatening. DECISIVE MOMENT pressed the pace outside EL COMMODORE into the stretch and tired. STREET GAME well placed early, made a run around the far turn to loom a threat, then faltered. EL COMMODORE set the pace under pressure along the rail into the stretch and faded.
