Footnotes

MASTER WESLEY unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run, rallied to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole, vied with HEIKO to deep stretch, then just lasted over SITUATIONAL ETHICS. The latter, outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run, then rallied to just miss. HEIKO pressed the pace along the inside, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, responded when headed by MASTER WESLEY in the stretch, then vied with that rival to deep stretch and gave way. BI FLASH stalked the pace off the rail into the stretch and closed with a mild response to just miss the show. GALACTICO rated off the pace, saved ground while advancing into contention around the far turn, then weakened in the drive. HURRY UP ALAN reserved off the pace, made a run four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then tired in the drive. GAELICO moved up on the backstretch to press the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then faltered. CORINTHIANO set the pace off the rail into the far turn, then faded. OXFORD STREET broke awkwardly and was through after a half mile.
