FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Closes Wednesday, March 22, 2006 with a fee of \$100, \$500 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$75,000 Guaranteed. The owner of the winner to receive \$45,000, \$15,000 to second, \$8,250 to third, \$4,500 to fourth and \$2,250 to fifth. WEIGHTS: Three Year Olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-Winners of \$24,000 twice since September 1, 2005, allowed 2 lbs.; \$28,000 once since November 1, 2005, 4 lbs.; three races other than Maiden or Claiming, 6 lbs. This race will be limited to 12 starters. (Equal Weights on the scale Preferred.) Total earnings in 2005-2006, will be used to determine the order of preference of horses with equal weight (on the scale). Closed Wednesday March 22, 2006 with 32 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 24 feet).

Footnotes

DRUM MAJOR stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside BOB'S PROUD MOMENT to gain the lead at the top of the stretch and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to hold REBEL REBEL (IRE) safe. The latter, reserved along the inside after breaking awkwardly, rallied along the rail in behind the winner around the far turn to reach the attending position but couldn't get to that rival while proving second best. WISHINGITWAS chased the pace, made a run at the leader racing into the stretch, then tired. SAINT STEPHEN rated off the pace, steadied in traffic leaving the first turn, advanced between horses to reach contention in the stretch, then flattened out. TERRIFIC STORM tracked the pace three wide, was outmoved into the stretch, then didn't do enough late. SIR SHACKLETON unhurried early, improved his position without threatening. KENNEL UP failed to menace. ECCLESIASTIC

chased the pace into the stretch, then faltered. BOB'S PROUD MOMENT showed speed along the inside to the top of the stretch, then had nothing left for the drive. SPRUCE RUN off slowly, was not a factor. SITCOM allowed to settle, advanced four wide on the far turn to reach contention, then faded. COTTAGE (ARG) trailed after breaking slowly.
