Footnotes

PROTAGONUS well placed, rallied three wide around the turn to take over at the top of the stretch, then edged away late under pressure. ROBBIES CHARM pressed the pace outside DILIGENT BID, moved to take over from that rival midway of the turn, responded when headed by PROTAGONUS in the stretch, then couldn't stay with that rival late while clearly best of rest. MOON'S HALO tracked the pace along the rail, eased out for the stretch run and couldn't keep pace with the top ones. HE'S A LUMBERJACK up close early, raced three wide on the turn and gave way. LUCKY CHIEF rated off the pace, made a run four wide on the turn to loom a threat, then tired in the drive. AWFULLY SMART was not a factor. GOTTTCHA GOLD raced along the rail and faltered. ARMAMENT raced four wide and faded. SMOKE EM AGAIN was outrun. DILIGENT BID showed speed along the inside to midway of the turn, stopped and was eased in the final eighth.
