Footnotes

CLIFF MEADOWS allowed to settle after being caught in tight at the start, rallied four wide around the far turn to take over at the top of the stretch, then was fully extended to hold off BIG JEROME. The latter, set the pace along the rail, eased back off FAGEDABOUDIT SAL on the far turn, was outmoved by several rivals into the stretch, angled out for racing room and came on again to be up for the place. UNBRIDLED HEAT reserved racing along the rail, advanced into contention around the far turn, was caught in traffic in the stretch, then finished willingly while just being edged for the place. FAGEDABOUDIT SAL chased the pace, moved up to take over from BIG JEROME on the backstretch, opened a clear lead on the far turn, made the pace to the top of the stretch, then weakened. B B FRANK was tracking the pace when steadied in behind rivals on the first turn, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch, then gave way. BANDIT PRINCE steadied along the inside on the first turn and failed to menace. GULF RUCKUS was done early. BROADWAY ACTOR rated off the pace, made a run three wide to join the leaders racing down the backstretch, stayed with those rivals into the far turn, then tired.
