BENGAL RIDGE rated off the pace, saved ground around the far turn, angled out and rallied to take over at the sixteenth pole, then was fully extended to last over LE ROYALE. The latter, unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and rallied to just miss. SURELY SENT reserved racing along the inside, eased out for the drive, was checked at the eighth pole when GLORY OF POWER drifted in front of him, recovered and rallied to be up for the show. COPPER FOREST vied for the lead along the inside, edged clear leaving the far turn, then gave way in the final sixteenth. GLORY OF POWER tracked the pace along the inside, eased out for the drive, made a run at COPPER FOREST, then drifted in a bit at the eighth pole and weakened in the final sixteenth. ACTOR'S GROOVE outrun early, closed with a belated rally. SIR JOHN failed to menace. OUR SUN vied for the lead outside COPPER FOREST to midway of the far turn, then tired. NICHOLAS VISION was not a factor. BOOMERANG STAR tracked the leaders three wide into the far turn, then faltered. MAGESTIC BILL tracked the pace into the far turn and faded. OUT OF AFRICA (SAF) was outrun while saving ground, then steadied to avoid running up on a rival on the far turn.
