RETIRE TO WHAT bumped with MATT'S A GIANT at the start, chased CAR THIEF into the stretch, then rallied to be just up at the wire. CAR THIEF showed speed along the rail into the stretch, then just failed to last. LOVE WHO reserved off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and closed to be just up for the show. HOLLYWOOD LEFT rated off the pace after breaking a step slowly, didn't do enough late. MATT'S A GIANT bumped with RETIRE TO WHAT at the start, then checked to avoid PETCH on the turn and failed to menace. GULF RUCKUS was not a factor. PETCH chased the pace into the turn and tired. TAHOE WARRIOR was outrun while saving ground.
