Footnotes

SENSOR stalked the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, then drew clear under urging. KEY TO POWER stalked the pace along the inside, angled three wide on the far turn, made a run to reach the attending position while drifting out under left-handed urging in midstretch, was straightened away but couldn't get to the winner while clearly second best. ENTRAINMENT unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn and closed to gain the show. MAGIC HARBOR failed to menace. TIZ YANKEE sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace to nearing the quarter pole, then tired. KILBEGGAN was done early.
