LIVINGSTON STREET stalked the pace along the inside into the backstretch the final time, eased out and rallied three wide to take over on the final turn, then drew clear under urging. LAUREATE CONDUCTOR stalked the pace three wide into the stretch the final time, then closed to gain the place while unable to get to the winner. SOLITAIRE reserved for more than a mile, angled out for the stretch run and couldn't gain late while up for the show. LEIPZIG raced three wide and failed to menace. CARNIVAL RIDE stalked the pace along the inside into the final turn, then tired. GO JOE GO set the pace into the final turn and faltered. RONIN DAX stalked the pace off the rail for a mile, then faded.
